Flag Pole and Display Policy

The “Freedom to Display the American Flag Act of 2005” prohibits a condominium association, cooperative association, or residential real estate management association from adopting any policy that would restrict or prevent a member of the association from displaying the flag of the United States of America. Nothing in the Act shall be considered to permit any display or use that is inconsistent with any reasonable restriction pertaining to the time, place, or manner of displaying the flag of the United States necessary to protect a substantial interest of the condominium association, cooperative association, or residential real estate management association.

Florida Statute 720.304 states that “Any homeowner may display one portable, removable United States flag or official flag of the State of Florida in a respectful manner, and on Armed Forces Day, Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, and Veterans Day may display in a respectful manner portable, removable official flags, not larger than 4¹/₂ feet by 6 feet, which represent the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard, or a POW-MIA flag, regardless of any declaration rules or requirements dealing with flags or decorations.”

Residents of Arbor Trace may display the flag of the United States, of an armed services, and POW-MIA consistent with Florida Statute. Permanent, free standing flag poles erected on individual resident properties are not permitted. Flag poles must be removable. Pole mounts should be attached to a permanent structure, preferably a house.
